Oregon State University's College of Engineering STUDENT SUCCESS INITIATIVE (SSI) SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

ADMISSION STATUS:

- The College of Engineering Student Success Initiative (SSI) Scholarship is a highly competitive, merit and needbased scholarship
- This scholarship is available only to students whose first term of enrollment at OSU will be the fall term.
- You must be a fully-admitted undergraduate engineering student enrolled at OSU to be eligible for receipt of funds.

* <u>IMPORTANT</u>: Please note that each year a placeholder titled "COE SSI Scholarship" will be added to your financial aid award offer. However, at the time of payment, this placeholder will be "cancelled" (it will show on your student account as \$0.00) and a scholarship account, which is funded by one of our generous College of Engineering donors, will take its place in the same dollar amount. <u>The funding provided by the donor is the fulfillment of your</u> <u>College of Engineering SSI Scholarship</u>.

PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS:

The annual award amount will be divided into *three equal installments* to be credited to your university billing account at the start of each term (Fall, Winter, and Spring) if you are enrolled full-time. Undergraduate full-time enrollment is defined as 12 or more credit hours per term. Degree Partnership Program (DPP) students must designate OSU as their home school, register for a minimum of 6 credit hours at OSU, and meet the overall full-time enrollment requirement in combination with the designated partner school each term to be eligible to receive the award.

SCHOLARSHIP RENEWAL:

The College of Engineering SSI Scholarship is renewable for up to three additional years (9 terms total) beyond your first year's award, provided that all of the following terms and conditions are met each year. The SSI Scholarship Terms and Conditions are as follows:

- You must enroll as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more per term) in a major within the College of Engineering
- You must maintain an OSU cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.50 or better.
- You must maintain satisfactory progress toward your engineering degree.
